Last night the Board met with Grundmeyer Leader Search (GLS) to finalize the process for finding the next Superintendent of Schools. GLS shared a tentative schedule that is an aggressive timeline in an attempt to get someone hired in May. GLS also shared that they are happy with the quality of the candidate pool thus far with a few more quality applicants completing their applications this week.

Formal interviews will take place on May 31 with three or four candidates all interviewing that day. A portion of the interviews is a Mixed Stakeholder Team, which will be made up of community members, parents, administration, staff, and students. Depending on the number of candidates interviewing, the interviews are tentatively planned to begin at 2 pm or 3 pm and expected to be completed by 7 pm. If you are interested in being a participant in the interviews, <u>please complete this form</u> before Sunday, May 22. Completing the form does not guarantee you will be on the committee, but rather you are interested. The Board will select the interview team members on Monday, May 23 when they also meet in closed session to review the candidates and determine finalists.

A press release will be sent out next week with the finalists' information. The interview team members selected to participate will be given the information and schedule on May 24. If selected, the interview team members are committing to participating in all interviews that day.
