Work Session – Facilities Study Survey Results
Colfax-Mingo Jr/Sr High School Business Room
Monday, June 8, 2015 – 6:00 pm

Struxture Architects presented the results of the district's facilities studies survey. It included input from elementary and junior/senior high staff and students, administration, school committee members, public members, and an online survey. Top concerns were inadequate athletic facilities, parking, 5th/6th grade placement at the elementary, and building security. Superintendent Lucas noted that the grade placement issues will be resolved for this fall, and the Board has approved a bid for the installation of security systems at both locations yet this summer. The Struxture team presented drawings to address parking options, the addition of a second gym/weight room and wrestling room, and additional class space at the high school. At the elementary, drawings depicted remodeling options to increase class space, secure the main entry into the building, and address space and seating in the gym. Eight community members, board members Becky Maher, Doug Garrett, Mardell Tomlonovic, BJ Russell, Skylar Rawlins and Don Goodman, and Principals Summy and Jones spent considerable time addressing pros and cons, and providing other options regarding the elementary, the former middle school and the junior/senior high sites. Struxture will continue developing options, and also will do a class space study to determine if building space is utilized to the maximum currently, or if there is a need to build additional classrooms.
