Special Board of Directors Meeting
Colfax-Mingo High School Media Center
Monday, September 22, 2014

- I. CALL TO ORDER: Board Secretary Debra Hodgson called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Roll call: Dr. Becky Maher, Jan Myers, Doug Garrett and Mardell Tomlonovic. Absent: Skylar Rawlins, Billie Jo Russell, Don Goodman. Administrators present: Superintendent Lucas and Principal Jones.
- II. Approval of Agenda: Tomlonovic moved, Myers seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 4-0.
- III. Recognition of Guests: None registered
- IV. Maher moved, Tomlonovic seconded to approve to move into closed session per Iowa Code 21.5(1)(e) and Iowa Code 21.5(1)(a) to consider recommended discipline of a student. Roll call: Ayes-Tomlonovic, Garrett, Maher, Myers. Nay-none. Motion carried 4-0. Time 5:34 pm.

Tomlonovic moved, Maher seconded to move to return to open session. Roll call: Ayes-Garrett, Maher, Tomlonovic Myers. Nay-none. Motion carried 4-0. Time 6:05 pm.
- V. Maher moved, Myers seconded to approve the recommendation that the student who was the subject of the disciplinary hearing submit to an alcohol assessment at the student's expense with release of the outcome of the assessment to the school. In addition, it is recommended the student submit to a mental assessment evaluation. Also, that the student be suspended through Friday, September 26, 2014. Prior to being readmitted to school, the student and parent must attend a re-admittance meeting with the principal. Further, the student will be placed on academic and behavioral probation for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year. Any similar incident with alcohol or any illegal substance or look-alike during the student's time at Colfax-Mingo High School may lead to a recommendation for expulsion from school. In addition, it is recommended the student submit to a mental assessment evaluation. Motion carried 4-0.
